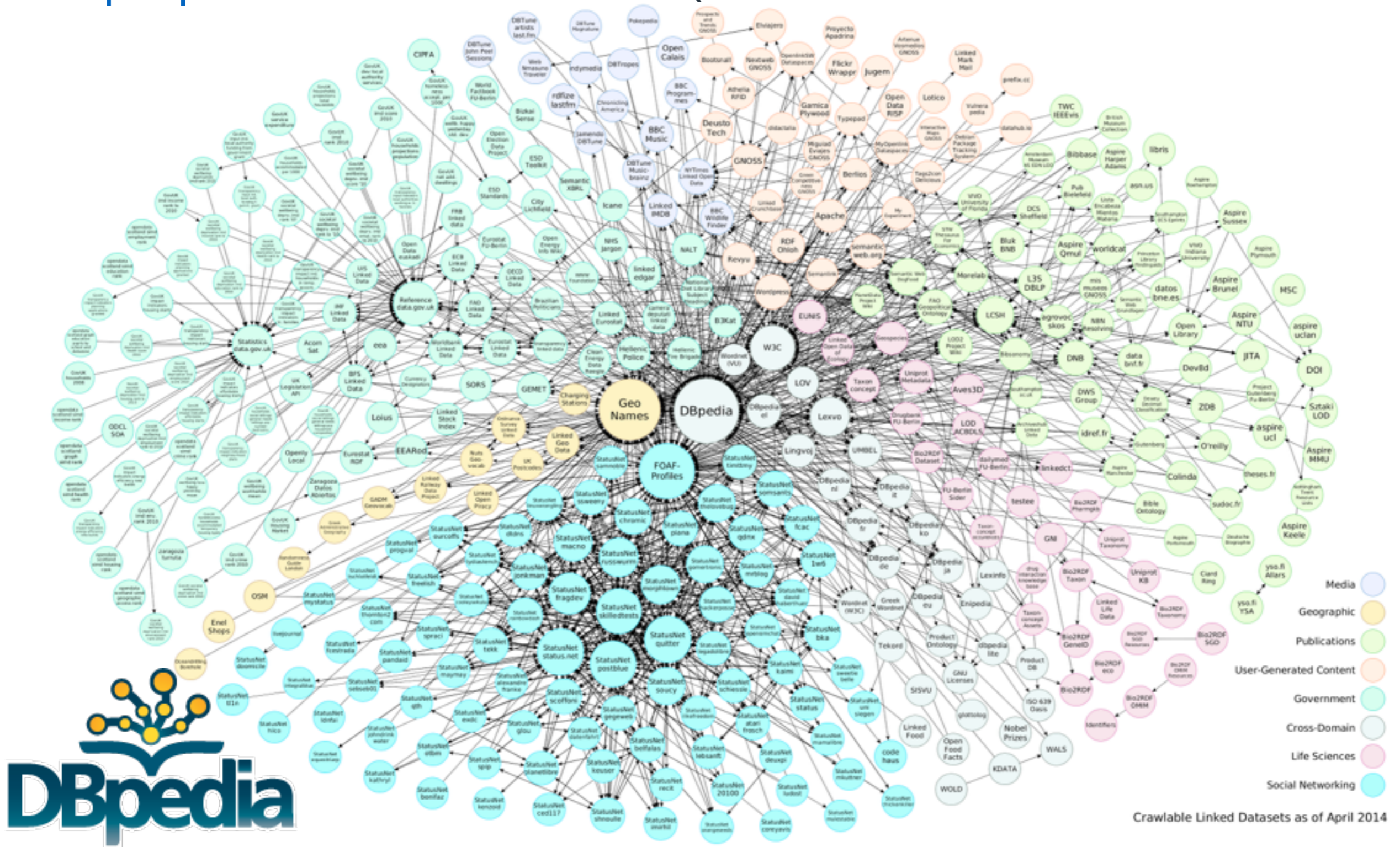

Giant Global Graph ,zweite Version' vom Semantic Web

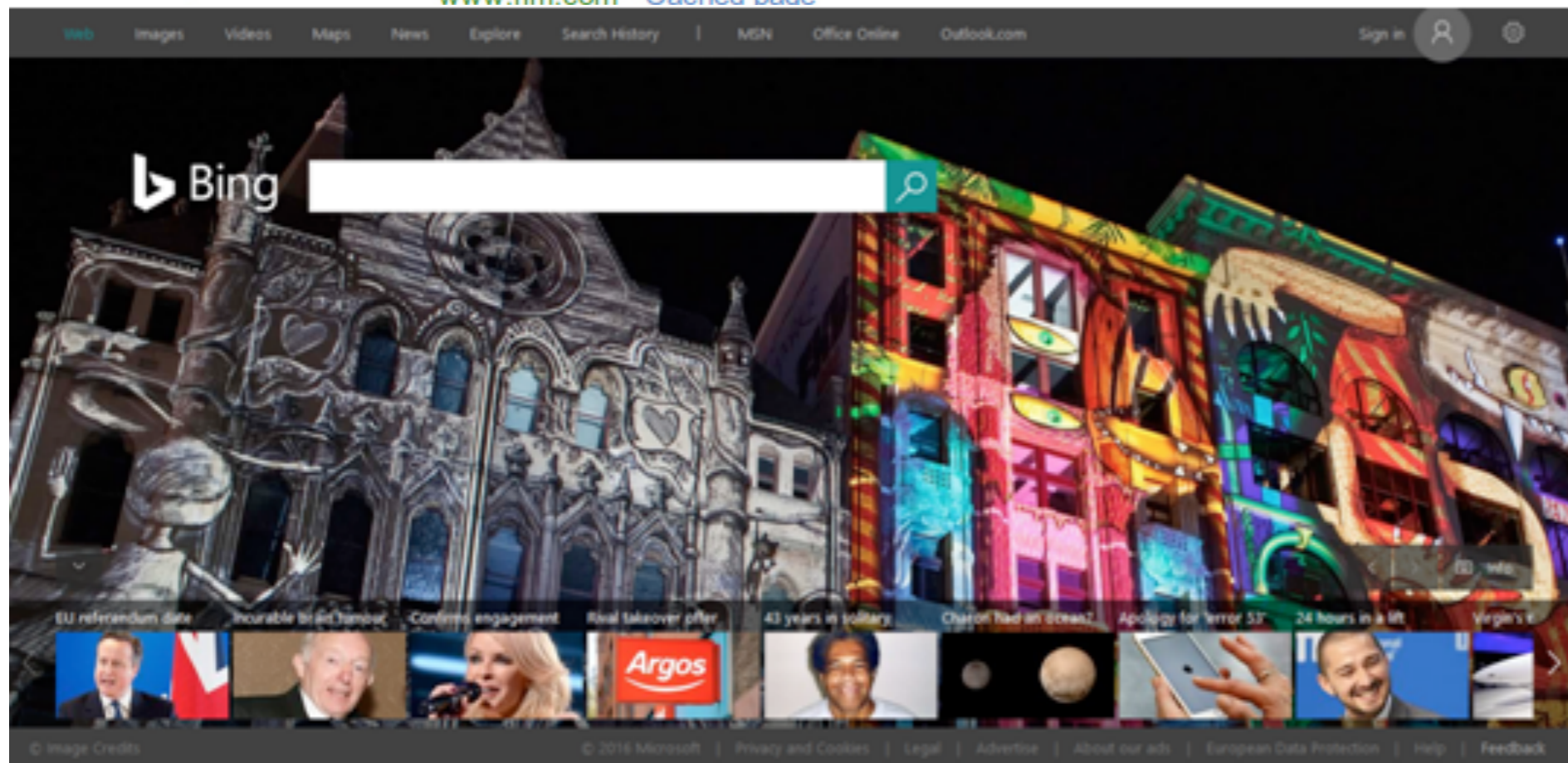
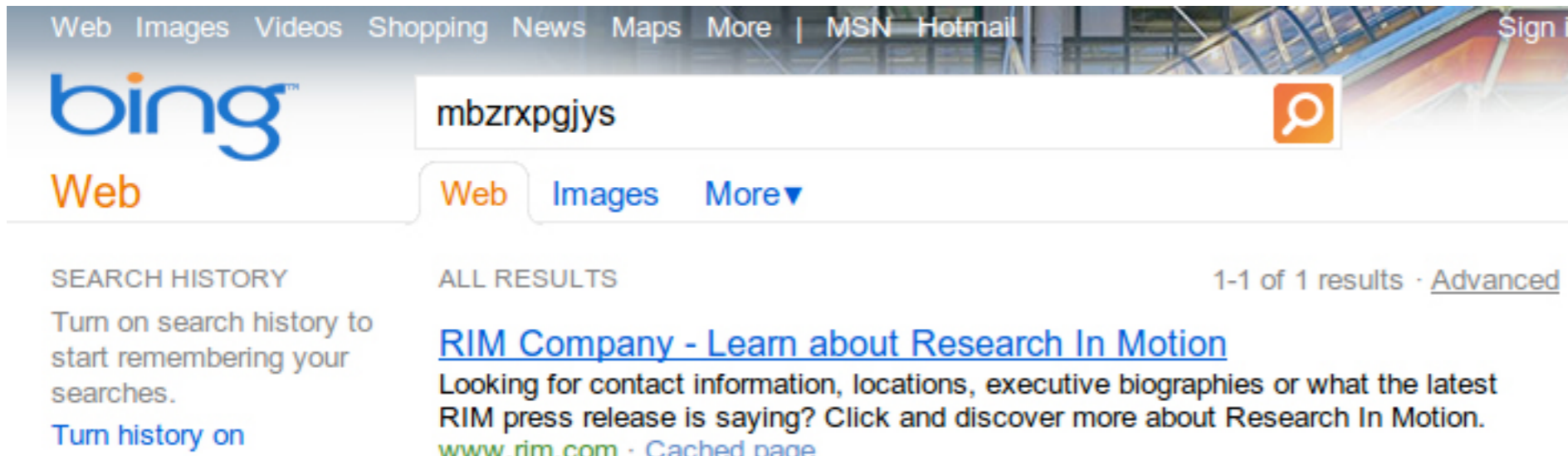

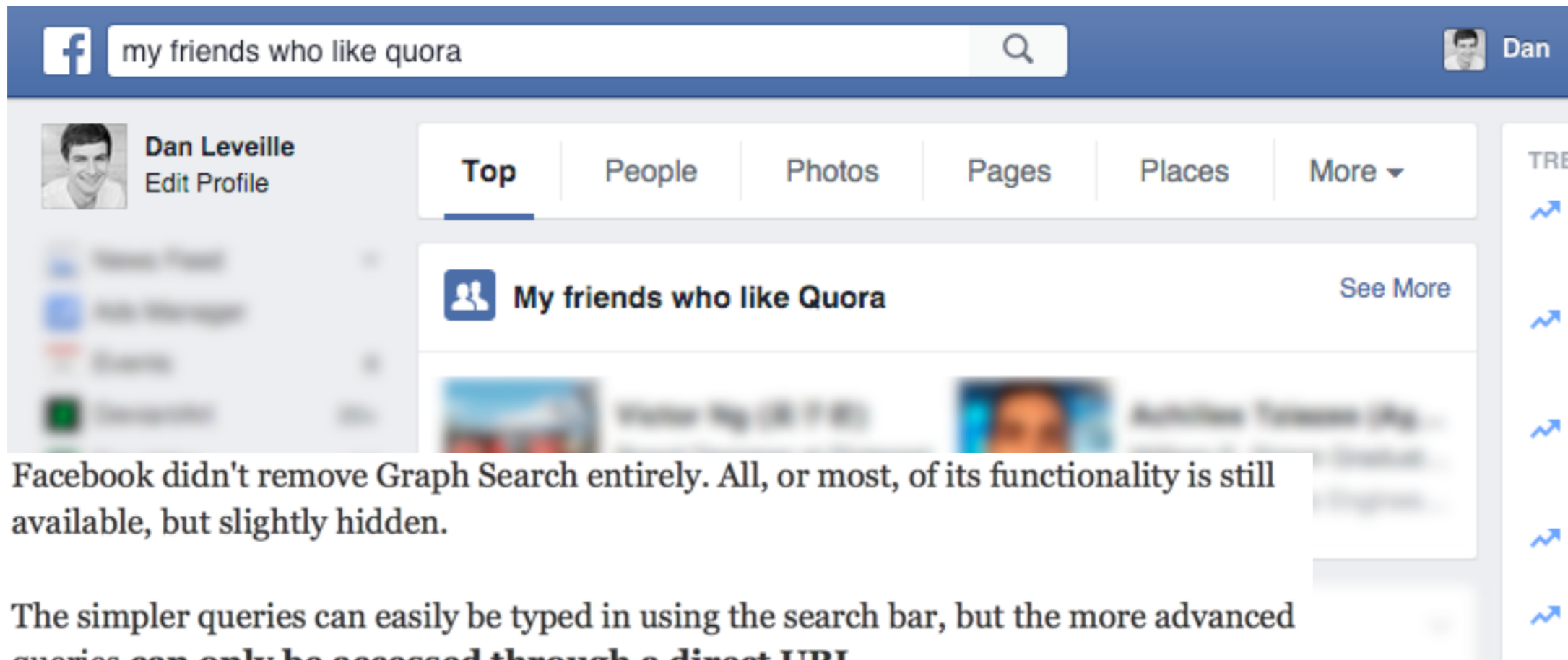
